





The Guest House at Minster Abbey is situated in the grounds of the ancient Abbey. Our guests are always warmly welcome to spend quiet time in the beautiful Abbey Chapel and to share in the prayer of the sisters and join us for Mass. The Abbey gardens create a prayerful, reflective environment, surrounded by the beauty of God's creation. There is a good selection of spiritual books available, and a sister can be available for a private conversation by prior arrangement.



Saint Anselm in the 11th century, , spoke of the importance of finding space in order to allow God to speak to the heart: "Come now, little one, get away from your worldly occupations for a while, escape from your tumultuous thoughts. Lay aside your burdensome cares Give yourself over to God for a little while, and rest for a while in Him"

We are delighted to tell you that our Guest House is now open. We have reordered the rooms in order to safely welcome a reduced number of guests on a self-catering basis, and this allows us to be open for most of the year. There is a minimum stay of at least 2 nights.



There are 4 distinct areas for guests. 2 are upstairs and 2 are downstairs, including a twin room with disabled facilities. Please let us know if you require this room when making your booking. Towels are provided.

Each guest area has a separate kitchenette with a microwave, a small fridge; a toaster and a kettle. We also provide supplies for a simple breakfast and beverages. We cannot provide for special diets nor can we guarantee a nut free environment. There is a local village supermarket that sells a good variety of microwave meals. Alternatively you may like to visit one of the local eating venues or takeaway facilities.



We can provide a room for a non-residential quiet day of prayer. A larger room for day groups of up to 30 people is also available. Both need to be booked in advance.

We also have a lovely self-contained Chalet which is suitable for a small family and is very comfortable. See our website for more details.


